#### **Purpose**

To create a framework for:

- Advocating accountability for responsible environmental management and resource conservation;
- Ensuring environmental legal compliance;
- The development and implementation of effective environmental management systems;
- Promoting a culture of continuous improvement to ensure ongoing alignment to internationally benchmarked environmental best practice.

### Scope

This statement of intent extends to all Group entities including the South African and international businesses, as appropriate. Management at each reportable segment of the Group is responsible for the effective implementation of the Groups' environmental management principles as relevant and appropriate to their operating environment.

# Environmental Management Principles

  materials with due regard to the scarcity of natural resources and the environmental impact
  resulting from the utilisation and application of such resources in conducting our business
  activities;
